MAINE HIGH ADVENTURE - 2024 Summer Reservation Form

Thank you for your interest in Maine High Adventure!

Here are a few of the details you will need to plan your trip to Maine.

PLANNING DETAILS

Where is Maine High Adventure:

Your initial destination is our base camp, Matagamon High Adventure Base, located at the northeast corner of Baxter State Park, on Grand Lake Matagamon, 27 miles northwest of Patten, Maine, and 37 miles from Interstate 95.

Summer Season: June 22 through August 26.

Crew Size: 7 to 11 including adults (larger groups are welcome, requires multiple MHA crews).

Adult Leadership: At least one leader 21 years old or older required while at MHA, two usually required while

traveling en route to/from MHA. Co-ed crews require one male and one female leader at least 21 years old.

Minimum Age: 13 years old before September 1, 2024

BSA Registration: All crew members must be registered members of the Boy Scouts of America.

Trip Length: Minimum stay is 6 nights. There is no maximum. 8-day trips are most popular. Longer trips offer great options!

Arrival and Departure: You can arrive and depart on any day of the week.

First Day: Plan to arrive by 8:00 am.

Next to the Last Day: Day your crew comes off-the-trail. MHA

provides dinner, showers, and lodging in cabins that night.

Last Day: You depart Matagamon Base at 8:00 am on the morning of your last day.

FINANCIAL DETAILS

Cost for 2024: \$124 Per person per night (regardless of crew size or number of nights).

Fee includes: FULL-TIME services of a well trained MHA guide, food from arrival to departure, trail equipment, and round-trip ground transport to/from put-in/take-out points.

Additional or potential additional costs:

- cost of travel to/from MHA.
- lodging or camping fees for night prior to MHA arrival.
- fishing licenses
- float plane option during trek.
- extra transportation for Mt. Katahdin climbs
- lost or damaged trail equipment

RESERVATION PROCESS

- Call or email with:
 1. first and second choice of arrival dates
 2. length of trip
 3. anticipated number of people in total group.
- Please verify age eligibility of all participants.
- After confirmation by MHA, telephone/email reservations will be held for 10 days pending receipt of reservation form and deposit.
- Complete planning and information packet will be sent after receipt of deposit.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

- \$600 NON REFUNDABLE deposit per crew is required to finalize your reservation.
- \$3000 payment due January 15. Crews registering after January 15 are expected to make the \$3000 payment within 30 days of their deposit. The *Advisors Preparation Kit*, containing participant manuals, medical forms, etc., will be sent upon receipt of the \$3000 payment.
- Payment of the remaining balance is due May 1.
- For payment and refund purposes, crews need to confirm group size prior to May 1, for the remaining balance payment. Note: Additional crew members can be added after final payment (up to the maximum 11 per crew). Payments for additional crew members can be made on arrival day. **LARGER CREWS ARE ENCOURAGED.**

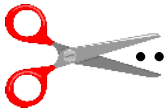


CANCELLATION POLICY

All fees (including deposit) are non-refundable and non-transferable in the event of cancellation, reduction of crew size or trek duration. Be cautious of making reservations or paying fees for those who have not made a financial commitment. Maine High Adventure Programs must commit financial resources to employ staff, purchase food and supplies, and prepare for base operations. Participants are, therefore, also required to make a financial commitment to attend. Be conservative in making reservations to avoid losing fees due to cancellations.
